This is an official ADGA Show & their rules shall govern.

1. The Senior, & Junior Doe Shows and the Buck shows are sanctioned **separately** for the following breeds; SENIOR DOES: *Alpine, LaMancha, Nigerian Dwarf, Nubian, Oberhasli, Saanen, AOP [Sable & Togg] & Recorded Grade*; JUNIOR DOES: *Alpine, LaMancha, Nigerian Dwarf, Nubian, Oberhasli, Saanen, AOP [Sable & Togg] & Recorded Grade*; BUCKS: *LaMancha, Nigerian Dwarf, Saanen & AOP [Alpine, Nubian, Oberhasli, Sable & Togg]*.
2. An original registration or recordation certificate is required for any goat six months of age or older. A *stamped duplicate* or *stamped FAXed duplicate* application is acceptable for kids under six months of age. Documents must be shown to the Show Secretary by 8:00 a.m. on June 4, 2011. A *copy* of the registration certificate, stamped duplicate application or stamped FAXed duplicate application will not be accepted. There will be no pre-show milk-out.
3. The base date for the shows are June 4, 2011. Goats must be in place by 8:30 a.m., June 4th - early arrivals may begin after 2:00 p.m. on Friday, June 3rd.
4. **Herdsmanship competition** – no charge – open to all exhibitors - see included rules *or* <http://adga.org/Scorecard.htm>
5. **Health Requirements:** All exhibitors are required to possess a *Health Certificate* issued within 30 days of the show date & indicating the name & tattoo of each goat to be shown. The *Health Certificate* must state: “*The animals being exhibited are free from any clinical signs consistent with those of foot-rot, scabies, sore-mouth, cutaneous fungal lesions, Scrapie or any other infectious or contagious disease.*” Each goat will be checked by a GA Dept. of Agriculture Inspector prior to show time. Georgia goats have no brucellosis or tuberculosis test requirements. ***Out-of-state*** goats must satisfy Georgia import requirements for brucellosis & tuberculosis - regulations are contingent on state of origin - call 404-656-3667 for current regulations. The GA Dept. of Agriculture Inspector's decision will be final.
6. Entry fee is \$11 per goat for both rings and \$6 per goat for ring 1 or 2. Pen fee is \$5 per pen. Payment must accompany the entry form & is **not** refundable!
7. Pens will be assigned by order of payment. A wood shaving base is provided, but you must bring your own bedding, if shavings are not sufficient. **Tack pens are NOT available!** Entry acceptance will be subject to pen availability or your ability to provide pens - to ensure space for your animals, please make your reservations early.
8. Exhibitors are responsible for keeping the aisle area in front & around their pens clean & unobstructed.
9. **Smoking is NOT permitted inside the building!** Dogs are not permitted in the building.
10. Prizes will be awarded for the ***Best Sr. Doe In Show, Best Jr. Doe In Show & Best Buck In Show.*** A stainless steel milking pail will be awarded for ***Best Dairy Herd.***
11. Goats competing in a group class must also be shown in their regular age class.
12. The Show Committee has a responsibility to the ADGA & to the GDGBA club to present dairy goats in a positive manner & to maintain order. The Show Committee will enforce regulations equally for all exhibitors. Improper [un-sportsman-like, disruptive, etc.] behavior will be handled by the Show Committee. When improper behavior is observed, the exhibitor will be given one warning. The Show Committee will explain what behavior was noticed & what actions will be taken if the behavior continues.

Ring 2 *LaMancha, Nigerian Dwarf, Saanen & AOP [Alpine, Nubian, Oberhasli, Sable, Toggenburg]*

Group Classes

Note: All breeds compete together.

Senior Doe Show

Ring 1

Dairy Herd class will compete in Ring 1 only.

Ring 2

Dam & Daughter class will compete in Ring 2 only.

Junior Doe Show

Ring 1

Produce of Dam class will compete in Ring 1 only.

Ring 2

Get of Sire class will compete in Ring 2 only.

NOTICE: The Senior Doe shows & the Junior Doe shows are sanctioned separately. The Senior Bucks & the Junior Bucks are combined into one show & are not sanctioned separately.
